SATURDAY 24th SEPT:

REGO/PRACTICE 8AM – 2:00PM
PROLOGUE 3PM

Registration and practice opens on Saturday 24th from 8am, riders must have registered and collected their race plate prior to practicing the stages on Saturday.

Prologue will be run after practice, the purpose of running a prologue stage is to seed riders from fastest to slowest within each category to ensure the field moves efficiently to the first race stage.

The prologue stage does not count towards your total race time, riders who do not participate in this stage will start from the back of their category.

Riders should be at the event village to be briefed on the Prologue stage at 2.30pm with racing to begin from 3pm.

SUNDAY 25th SEPT:

REGO 8-8:30AM
RIDER BRIEFING 8:45AM
RACING TO BEGIN FROM 9AM

Rider briefing will commence at 8.45AM on Sunday prior to racing at the event village, riders will depart in their seeded groups and follow the event signage to the various special stages.

Riders in classes U15, U17 and Sport Men/Women will do one less stage than the rest of the field and therefore skip stage three.

The event will be run as a multiple stage event, including timed special stages and liaison stages. Competitors must follow the event organisers rules and route and must follow the states road rules.

Riders must ride no more than two abreast while on public roads and be aware of traffic at all times.

STAGE INFORMATION

Riders will follow the liaison stages to and from the various race stages to ensure that the flow of rider traffic moves quickly and safely throughout the event, it is especially important that these liaison stages are followed so as to not corrupt your timing data through out the event.

Riders must wear a helmet at all times, full faced helmets must be used on race stages, open face helmets are permitted for liaison stages. Under 15/17 must have knee pads/elbow pads and full fingers gloves.

The race stages are as follows;
Wombat, stage closes at 10.20AM
Pins and Needles, stage closes at 10.45AM
Charlotte's (excluding Sport Male & Female, Under 15/17)
Fire road, Crits Decent.
Pink Line/Rocksalt, stage OPENS at 11.00AM
Fall Line, stage OPENS at 11.15AM

Other Information:

Lunch is provided for all competitors after racing and your lunch coupon can be collected when registering. All riders bikes will be checked for bar end plugs and to be in good order.

EVENT PARKING:

The event village will be located in the Hillview Community Reserve, Boundary Rd Dromana, parking will be adjacent to this and signposted, in the event that the area is unable to be used parking is to be done on Boundary Road towards Collins Road, local riders are encouraged to be dropped off where possible to save car spaces.
